As we reflect on 2023, a year filled with extraordinary achievements, we are honored to share some of the incredible progress CFLeads has made. Thanks to the unwavering support of the community foundation field, CFLeads has navigated a year of remarkable impact, growth, and innovation.

In 2023, we've expanded our team, doubling our capacity and enhancing the depth and breadth of our services, allowing us to support and engage community foundations on a larger scale.

We have had the honor of working with 26 community foundation leaders through our Executive Leadership Institute who have expressed overwhelming satisfaction with the program. CFLeads webinars, in collaboration with many inspiring partners, have reached hundreds of community foundation leaders, sparking important conversations and providing valuable insights on the most pressing issues of our time.

One of the most monumental highlights of 2023 was securing a groundbreaking \$5.2M grant from The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to support our growing economic mobility work. This funding is a testament to the trust and confidence placed in CFLeads to support the

community foundation field in enhancing economic mobility across the nation. Through our Connecting Communities in the Americas (CCA) initiative, we've strengthened partnerships across the Americas, tackling challenges that extend beyond borders. Additionally, in collaboration with Welcoming America, we proudly launched a Community of Practice for 15 community foundations designed to support their deepening welcoming and belonging work and knowledge of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Our work in 2023 was inspired by community foundations making meaningful change in their communities and gathering to share best practices with their colleagues. In the fall of 2023, CFLeads invited our community foundation Investors to convene for an exclusive two-day event featuring tailored, high-quality content and networking opportunities, with high-caliber speakers such as Dr. Danielle Allen and Dr. Gail Christopher.

As we look to the future, we are energized by the possibilities. We would like to take this opportunity to express our deepest gratitude to the entire community foundation field, whose support of CFLeads is crucial in maintaining the momentum we've built. Together, as a field, we can continue to drive meaningful change and shape the future of community foundations. Onward!


